

CAHON Young Investigator Award (YIA)

Up to six YIAs will be awarded to CAHON members who are physician-in-training or in early career development based on the scientific merit of their abstracts submitted to the 2015 ASH meeting. Each CAHON YIA awardee will receive \$500 in support of expenses to attend ASH meeting. The application deadline is 11:59pm Central Time on November 20, 2015.

Eligibility for consideration of CAHON YIA:

- Being a CAHON member who is the first author or senior author of an abstract to be presented at the 2015 ASH annual meeting

- Will attend the CAHON YIA award ceremony during the 2015 ASH meeting
- Being a physician-in-training (residency or fellowship training) or with 10 years after fellowship training at the level of instructor or assistant professor

- Accepted 2014 ASH abstract, abstract category (clinical or translation or others), presentation time
- 2-page CV, include education and current training level or position
